## GENERAL EDUCATION DUAL CREDIT/ENROLLMENT/EARLY ADMISSION APPLICATION AND RECOMMENDATION

A student who is currently attending high school may register to take courses under Meridian Community College's Dual Credit/Enrollment program provided he/she:

- is classified as a high school junior or senior as documented by an official high school transcript
- has maintained a 3.00 grade point average or better on all high school courses as documented by an official high school transcript
- received an unconditional written recommendation from their high school principal and/or counselor, with parental signature

NOTE: Students should be aware that they must maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher in dual credit classes to be eligible for financial aid at MCC. If the course is to be counted for secondary credit, a B average must be maintained during the first two (2) courses and all thereafter.

A student who is being home-schooled must submit a transcript prepared by a parent, guardian or custodian with a signed, sworn affidavit to meet the first and second requirements above. They must also have a written recommendation from the parent, guardian or custodian to meet the third requirement above.

A student who is not a junior or senior may enroll at MCC under the Dual Credit/Enrollment program if he/she has a composite score of 30 or higher on the American College Test (ACT) in addition to the 3.00 grade point average and unconditional recommendation.

Under MCC's Early Admission program, a student who has completed 14 core high school units and has earned an ACT composite of 26 or higher may enroll as a full-time student provided a principal or guidance counselor recommends that it is in the best educational interest of the student.

Dual Credit/Enrollment/Early Admissions applicants must submit an application for admission, an official high school transcript and this completed form. The students must meet the academic requirements for placement (i.e. score on a standardized test, etc.) in specific courses and will not be allowed to take any college English courses unless all English requirements of his/her school have been met.

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## CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION DUAL CREDIT/ENROLLMENT/EARLY ADMISSION APPLICATION AND RECOMMENDATION

A student who is currently attending high school may register to take courses under Meridian Community College's Career and Technical Education (CTE) Dual Credit program provided he/she:

- is classified as a high school sophomore, junior or senior as documented by an official high school transcript,
- has received an unconditional written recommendation from their high school principal and/or counselor, with parental signature
- received the written acceptance into a CTE course from an MCC CTE instructor based on a student interview.

Dual Enrollment/Early Admissions CTE applicants must submit an MCC application for admission, an official high school transcript, submit ACT or Accuplacer scores, and this completed form. Students must meet academic requirements for placement (i.e. minimum score on standardized tests, etc) in a specific course when required. Students will not be allowed to take any college courses with pre-requisites unless all pre-requisites are met.

NOTE: Students should be aware that they must maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher in dual credit classes to be eligible for financial aid at MCC. If the course is to be counted for secondary credit, a B average must be maintained during the first two (2) courses and all thereafter.
