The MCC's Fine Arts Department presents this performance which is suitable for audiences of all ages

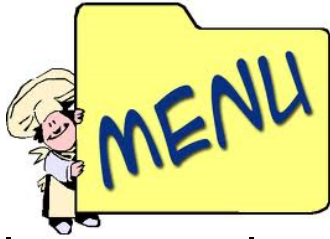

A valid I-20 is considered current for use if page three of the I-20 has been signed Dean Soraya Welden or Payne between February and December. This document, with current signature, will be required to be presented by the student to U.S. Customs officials upon their return stateside for the January term.

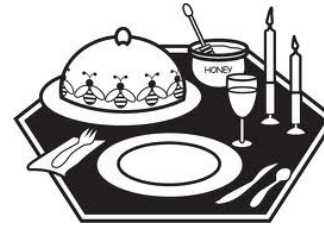

The drawing will be held in Olin Thomas' classroom in Reed Hall.

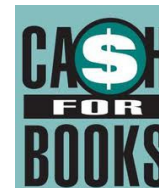


### Dining times
