

## Point System: Associate Degree Nursing

Implemented: February 21, 2003 (Revised: 2010)

Applicants receive residency points for one of the following:

<b>Residency Status</b>	<b>Points Awarded</b>
Current MCC student	4
Lauderdale Co. Resident (In-district)	4
Mississippi Resident (In-state)	2
Out of state	1

Applicants receive points based on their national ACT composite score. The residual ACT is not accepted by MCC.

<b>ACT Composite Score</b>	<b>Points Awarded</b>
17	1
18-20	2
21-24	3
25-28	4
28 or above	5

Applicants receive points for cumulative GPA, which is based on all college coursework.

<b>Cumulative GPA</b>	<b>Points Awarded</b>
2.0-2.5	1
2.6-3.0	2
3.1-3.5	3
3.5 or above	4

Applicants receive points for coursework based on the grade earned in each individual course. Points for science courses are based on the lecture grade if lab is taken as a separate course.
