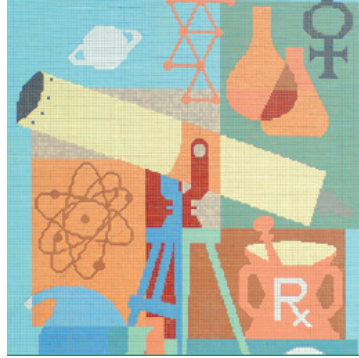

# Counselor Information

## Getting Admitted

Students seeking admission to MCC must submit the following:

1. A completed Application for Admission.
2. An official high school transcript. This transcript must show the date of graduation and the principal's signature.
3. A copy of the student's scores on the American College Test (ACT) or on the ACCUPLACER test. ACCUPLACER is given free on the MCC campus. Call 601-483-8241 to set up a test time if you have not taken the ACT.

# Counselor Information Orientation

Orientation is registration for all new degree-seeking students at MCC. You'll meet with an academic advisor to create your class schedule, in addition to learning other essential information about becoming a student at MCC. Orientation is mandatory for all new degree-seeking students at MCC. You must attend an orientation session in order to register for classes. Freshman and Transfer Orientation is a one-day event, and families should plan to be on campus through lunch. Students should plan to be on campus for approximately four hours after their check-in time.

Students must pre-register to attend an orientation session and be admitted to MCC in order to fully participate.

# Counselor Information

## Dual Credit / Dual Enrollment

- **Step 1:** Receive dual credit paper work (print the documents or pick up a copy from your high school counselor)
- **Step 2:** Return completed paperwork into school counselor/registrar for processing  
**Packets include the following:**  
MCC Application for Admission (completed each semester, mark Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment)  
Completed dual credit form for new students not currently taking a Spring 2017 dual credit class, OR a completed dual credit renewal form  
SSN #, Course name and time (example: English Composition, Tuesday nights; College Algebra, online), Semester you are taking the course, High School GPA, and Signatures of parent, principal/administrator, and counselor
- **Step 3:** Include your most current partial High School Transcript (note: home school student transcripts must be notarized)
- **Step 4:** Include your ACT or Accuplacer test scores (call 601-483-8241 to set up a test time for Accuplacer if you have not taken the ACT)

**A student may only enroll in Meridian Community College's General Education Dual Credit Program if he/she:**

- has 14 core units on an official high school transcript
- is a Junior or Senior in high school
- has at least a 3.0 GPA
- has received written recommendation from their high school principal and/or counselor, with parental signature

**A student who is currently attending high school may register to take courses under Meridian Community College's Career and Technical Education (CTE) Dual Credit program provided he/she:**

- is classified as a high school sophomore, junior or senior as documented by an official high school transcript,
- has received an unconditional written recommendation from their high school principal and/or counselor, with parental signature
- received the written acceptance into a CTE course from an MCC CTE instructor based on a student interview.
