**Surgical Technology (SUT)** is a 2-year degree program that prepares an individual to serve as a member of the surgical team to work with surgeons and other surgical personnel in delivering patient care and assuming appropriate responsibilities before, during, and after surgery.

The following must be on file with the Admissions Office by the May 1st program deadline:

- Application for Admission to MCC (indicate SUT program on application)
- Official High School Transcript or GED Scores
- ➤ All official and updated College transcript(s)
- ▶ ACT Scores, if taken (MCC does <u>not</u> accept residual ACT scores)
- > ACCUPLACER scores (if applicable), must be administered at Meridian Community College
