



Surgical Technology (SUT) is a 2-year degree program that prepares an individual to serve as a member of the surgical team to work with surgeons and other surgical personnel in delivering patient care and assuming appropriate responsibilities before, during, and after surgery.

☐ **STEP 1: ADMISSION TO MCC (must be fully admitted)**

The following must be on file with the Admissions Office by the May 1st program deadline:

- Application for Admission to MCC (indicate **SUT** program on application)
- Official High School Transcript or GED Scores
- All official and updated College transcript(s)
- ACT Scores, if taken (**MCC does not accept residual ACT scores**)
- ACCUPLACER scores (if applicable), **must be administered at Meridian Community College**

NOTE: Applications may be accepted after the deadline based on program availability.
